**NV Billecart-Salmon Brut Reserve** 235  
Mareuil-sur-Aÿ

*This refined non-vintage Champagne is known for its elegance and finesse. It blends Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, and Chardonnay, offering fresh aromas of citrus, green apple, and subtle brioche. The palate is crisp, with a creamy texture and a clean, balanced finish. Aged for 3-4 years on lees, it delivers complexity with a refreshing, lingering finish. Produced by the prestigious Billecart-Salmon house, established in 1818, it is renowned for its commitment to quality and craftsmanship in Champagne-making.*

**2022 Pascal Reverdy 'Terre de Maimbray' Sauvignon Blanc** 156  
Sancerre, Loire Valley, France

*Savor vibrant aromas of citrus fruits and fresh-cut grass, accompanied by delicate floral notes. On the palate, experience the crisp acidity and lively flavors of grapefruit, green apple, and tropical fruits, leading to a clean and refreshing finish.*

**2022 Mader 'Rosacker' Grand Cru Riesling** 179  
Alsace, France

*This wine reveals vibrant acidity, delicate floral aromas, and lively citrus flavors, embodying the esteemed characteristics of the Riesling varietal. Sourced from the renowned Rosacker vineyard, it offers a distinguished expression of Alsace's terroir, showcasing the region's unique flavors and textures. The wine is light to medium-bodied, with bright acidity and a clean, slightly salty finish. Produced using organic farming and minimal intervention, it highlights Sicily's coastal terroir.*

**2022 Rosi Schuster 'Aus Den Dorfern' Grüner Veltliner blend** 116  
Burgenland, Austria

*This captivating white blend is dominated by Grüner Veltliner, with touches of Pinot Blanc, Welschriesling, Chardonnay, and elements from traditional 'Gemischter Satz' vineyards. The wine presents a kaleidoscope of flavors and textures, offering a brilliant introduction to this renowned estate. The nose reveals smoky, yeasty notes, while the medium-bodied palate is expressive with aromas of apple puree and preserved lemon. Its lively dryness leads to a long, supple finish.*

Morgon, Beaujolais, France

*Crafted by Dominique Piron, a respected producer in the region, this wine is a vibrant expression of the renowned Gamay grape. It boasts lively red fruit flavors, balanced acidity, and smooth tannins, leading to a harmonious finish. This elegant wine showcases the purity and finesse of Morgon's terroir, making it a standout choice for lovers of sophisticated Beaujolais.*

2021 **By Farr** 'RP' Côte Vineyard *Pinot Noir* 393  
Geelong, VIC

*Pinot Noir from the cool-climate Geelong region, known for its elegance and complexity. Made from a specific block within the Côte Vineyard, it showcases vibrant red fruit flavors like cherry and raspberry, with earthy, mineral, and subtle spice notes. Aged in French oak, it offers silky tannins, balanced acidity, and a refined finish. The wine is crafted with a minimalist, hands-off approach, allowing the terroir to shine through.*

2021 **Donnafugata** 'Floramundi' *Nero d'Avola, Frappato* 159  
Cerasuolo di Vittoria DOCG, Sicily, Italy

*Donnafugata, meaning "fugitive lady," draws its name from a Sicilian legend of Queen Maria Carolina, who sought refuge in a villa on the estate. Just as the name evokes a sense of elegance and escape, the 2021 Floramundi blends the intensity of Nero d'Avola and the floral freshness of Frappato, offering vibrant notes of red berries, violet, and a touch of herbaceous spice. A truly expressive and harmonious wine, it reflects the spirit of Sicily's diverse terroir.*

2021 **Munda** 'Kaurna Country' *Shiraz* 133  
McLaren Vale, SA

*This McLaren Vale Shiraz, with its ripe blackberry and plum aromas and velvety tannins, pays homage to the traditional owners, the Kaurna people, who have inhabited the Adelaide Plains for thousands of years, embodying their deep cultural heritage and ongoing efforts to reclaim and preserve their language, traditions, and connection to the land amidst a history of colonial disruption.*

2022 **Sami-Odi** 'Hoffmann Dallwitz' *Shiraz* 360  
Barossa, SA

*Premium Barossa Valley Shiraz from a boutique winery known for its minimal-intervention approach. The wine showcases intense dark fruit flavors like blackberry and plum, with hints of spice, pepper, and earthy undertones. It is full-bodied, with velvety tannins and a long, persistent finish. Hand-harvested and aged in French oak, it balances power with elegance.*
